دعاء الإفطار: اللهم لك صمتُ و بك آمنْتُ و عليك توكلْتُ و على رزقك أفطرتُ.

Dua for Iftar: "O Allah! For You have I fasted, in You did I believe, on You did I rely, and with Your food did I break my fast."

يا أيها الذين آمنوا كتب عليكم الصيام كما كتب على الذين من قبلكم لعلكم تتقون. (القرآن الكريم)
"O believers! Fasting is prescribed upon you as it was prescribed upon those who were before you, that you may learn self-restraint."

عن أبي هريرة رضي الله عنه قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم: قال الله عز وجل: كل عمل ابن آدم له إلا الصيام، فإنه لي وأنا أجزي به، والصيام جنة، فإذا كان يوم صوم أحدكم فلا يرفث يومئذ ولا يصخب، فإن سابه أحد أو قاتله، فليقل: إني امرؤ صائم. والذي نفس محمد بيده لخلوف فم الصائم أطيب عند الله يوم القيامة من ريح المسك. وإذا أفطر فرحان: إذا أفطر فرح بفطره، وإذا لقي ربه فرح بصومه.
Abu Hurairah narrates, saying that the Prophet said: "Allah says: Every act of the son of Adam is for him, except fasting. It is meant for me and I will reward for it. Fasting is a shield, so when one of you is fasting on a day, let him not indulge in obscene language, not raise the voice; or if anyone reviles him or tries to quarrel with him, he should say: I am a person fasting. By Him in whose Hand is the life of Muhammad, the breath of a fasting person is sweeter to Allah on the Day of Judgement than the fragrance of Musk. The fasting person has two occasions of joy: one when he breaks his fast, he is pleased with it, and one when he meets his Lord, he is pleased with his fast."

Please recite the *Quran* regularly in this blessed month of Ramadan Do not miss your prayers. Make charities and be charitable. Guard against your tongues and deeds in accordance to the requirement and spirit of fasting.

The time for *Suhur* starts after midnight and remains till just before the *Fajr* breaks out. Make sure you finish your *Suhur* 5 minutes before the *Fajr* time.
